PLEASE READ AND SIGN

I understand that agility training is an activity that is held at a public facility in the presence of other dogs and their owners. I understand that participation in agility training will require some physical activity on my part and on the part of my dog. I also understand that this activity will involve running, jumping, and the use of obstacles such as scaffolding, A-frames, tunnels, scaling planks, jumps and tires that could result in injury to me, to my dog, or to others.

I represent that I am in good health and my dog is in good health; that my dog is friendly and not a hazard to other persons or dogs; that I will examine the equipment provided for the class, along with the premises, prior to permitting my dog to engage in agility activities, and that I will participate at my own risk and not hold the Agility Club, its Board of Directors or officers, the instructors, or any and all persons or entities associated with the Agility Club liable for any loss, injury, illness, expense or other hardship that may arise in connection with my participation, or my dog's participation, in this activity.

I understand if my dog is in heat, pregnant or nursing; lame, blind or sick, they are restricted from participating in training.

Although aggression from dogs in agility is unacceptable, it is behavior that we, as a club, inevitably will encounter. Therefore, the following policies apply to behavior in agility classes:

1. It is ALWAYS the handler's responsibility to make sure their dog has enough space and to notify other handlers of their dog's issues. It is also expected that ALL handlers will be aware of their requirement to keep their dog controlled around ANY dog, whether or not they are wearing a yellow or red bandana.
2. Dogs must be on leash at all times. The exception to this is when the dog is running a set, but he/she must be leashed immediately upon completion of the sequence.
3. Crate Rule – All dogs must be crated upon arrival to class for set-up and at the close of class for tear down – NO EXCEPTIONS. This is for the dog's safety and so you are free to help with class preparations.
4. Aggressive behavior will be determined by the instructor/training director. The following course of action will be followed if a dog exhibits inappropriate behavior:
 - A. First incident
 - 1) Red bandana rule goes into effect and the dog is placed on 12-month probation.
 - 2) The Head Instructor fills out an incident report and notifies the Training Director.
 - 3) The leash-at-all-times rule is reiterated to all students.
 - 4) Crate rule is re-emphasized to all students.
 - B. Second incident
 - 1) Mandatory obedience and/or behavioral training *and* suspension from class.
 - 2) Documentation must be presented stating that the dog has successfully completed the equivalent of 8 weeks of training.
 - 3) An evaluation of the dog's behavior around other dogs is made by the staff of the class.
 - 4) If both are done successfully, the dog may return to class.
 - 5) The red bandana rule is still in effect and the 12-month probation re-starts.
 - 6) The Head Instructor must record the results on an incident report and contact the Training Director.
 - 7) The Training Director will contact the dog's handler and notify them of reinstatement.
 - 8) The leash rule and crate rule are re-emphasized again and a reminder goes out about the Aggression Policy.
 - C. Third incident
 - 1) The dog is expelled from GDA.
 - 2) If the handler feels this final step is unwarranted, the handler has 30 days to make an appeal to the Board of Directors whose decision is final in this matter.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for my decision to attend and/or participate in a GDA event, and any personal injury, disability, illness, death, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my participation in a GDA event.

I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless Good Dog Agility Club (GDA), its officers, agents, representatives, volunteers, members, local trial hosts, judges and participants from any and all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating to my attendance and/or participation in a GDA event. I understand and agree that this Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID19 covers any claims regardless of whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any GDA event.

GDA Coronavirus Safe Classes Protocol Fall/Winter 2020-2021

Biggest Risks

- Close range/face to face contact
- Enclosed space for long periods
- High-touch surfaces

Virus Protocol

- 1. If you are ill or if you have been exposed, please stay home.**
 - a. If you have possibly exposed other club members, please contact your instructor ASAP**

Note: if a class has been exposed, the following 2 classes will be cancelled for quarantine
2. Set-up - *being outside is less risky – aerosol transmission is low*
 - a. Put mask on upon exiting your vehicle
 - b. Please do not crowd at the gate when entering and exiting. Stay at least 6' away
 - c. Set up crates at least 6' apart
 - d. One handler/one dog is preferred – exceptions on case-by-case basis
 - e. Guests will not be permitted but if a non-member must come for some reason, a waiver will need to be signed. Speak with your instructor.
 - f. Prefer only one parent of Jr Handler
3. Equipment Trailer - *confined areas = higher risk*
 - a. Wear masks
 - b. Gloves are optional (see c. below)
 - c. Use hand sanitizer before and after moving equipment (GDA to provide)
 - d. One person in trailer to hand out equipment
 - e. Stay 6' apart as much as possible
4. Field - *being outside is less risky – aerosol transmission is low*
 - a. Keep appropriate distance – at least 6 feet
 - b. No close visiting/physical contact
 - c. Wear masks – unless you need to remove when running a set

Failure to adhere to these safety measures could put fellow GDA members at risk. An instructor will ask you to leave the practice site if compliance is refused.
