Welcome to Good Dog Agility's January 2023 Show!

Schedule:

Friday Setup: 4:00pm – 6:00pm (**Volunteers only** may setup their canopies once field setup is complete; **Please leave your canopies/mats on the basketball court inside the field until ring setup is complete** except for Chief Ring Stewards, Chief Course Builders, Show Chair, Equipment Mgr and Secretary)

Saturday/Sunday: Gates open at 7:00am
Check-in/Measuring 7:30am – 8:00am
Briefing 8:00am
Walk Thrus 8:10am
First Dog on the Line 8:30am

Course Running: Masters courses will not be walked until the prior Masters course has completed. Ring 1 will take priority. Grand Prix/Steeplechase and Biathlon will run in groups to eliminate conflicts. There will be a walk-thru for each group prior to running; Walk-run, Walk-run.

Site Restrictions: Do not allow your dog to pee on anything man made, stay off playground, no smoking or alcoholic beverages, please pick up poop even if it's not your dog's.

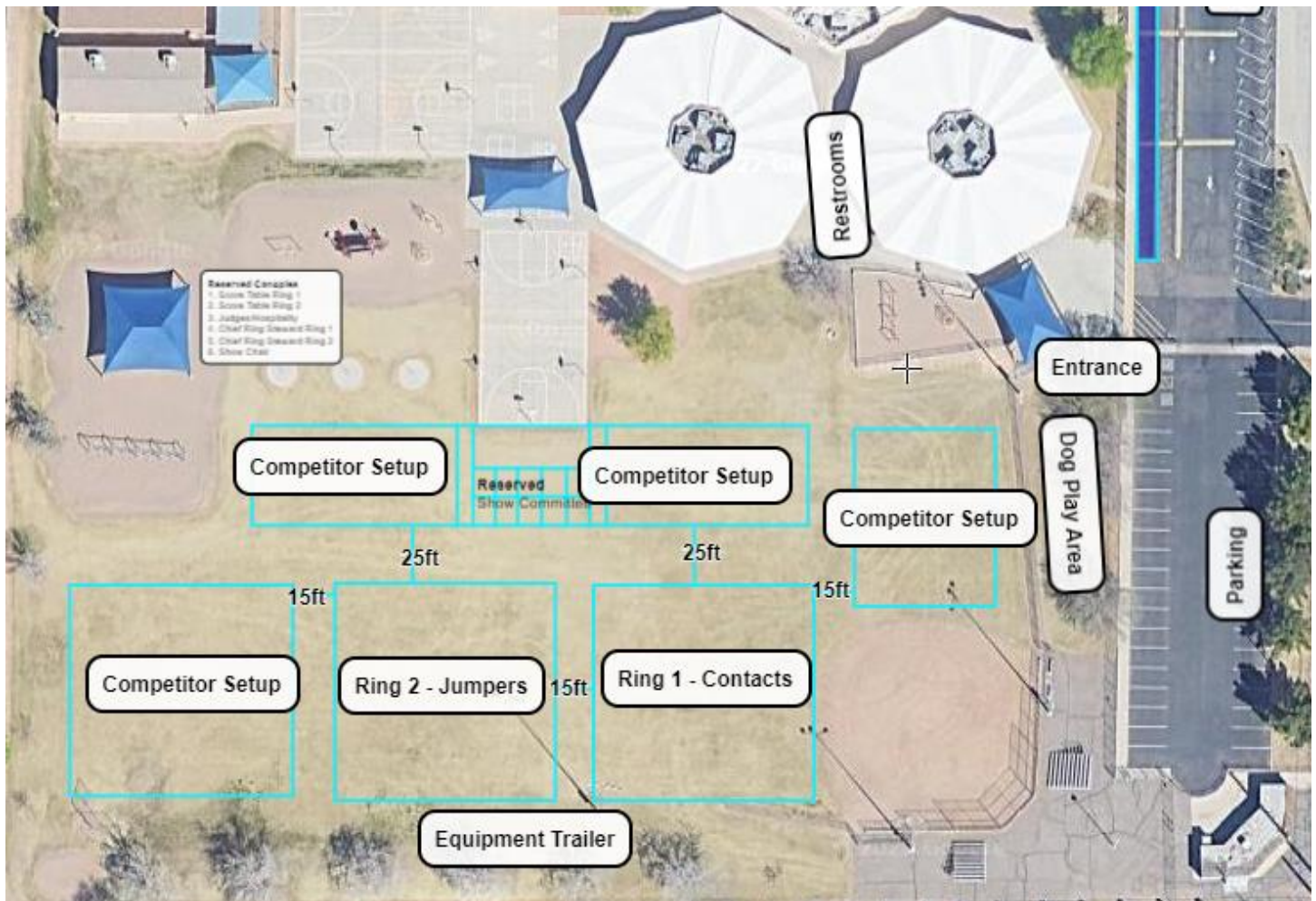
Setup: Competitor setup will be on Saturday/Sunday at 7:00am unless you help setup on Friday afternoon at 4:00pm. There will be security at the site overnight, and the gates will be locked overnight. Leave your belongings at your own risk.

Parking: Cars can park in the two parking lots east of the school along Extension. Larger vehicles/trucks can park in the East end of Fiesta Sports Park parking lot, north of the school. There is a crosswalk directly onto the school grounds. **Overflow and RV's should park at Fiesta Sports Park.**



Field Layout:

There should be plenty of space for everyone to setup. We will mark the border with flags where you can set up behind to make sure there is adequate space away from the rings. There will also be a fenced dog play area that can be entered from the dugout.

**Food:**

A hot lunch will be available for volunteers at 11:30 each day in the hospitality tent. Snacks and water will be provided as well. Please use the hand sanitizer provided before serving your lunch.
