We will not start running in a ring until both rings have completed their rotations. ## Wild West Regional 2025 Trial Information

Thank you for supporting USDAA and Good Dog Agility! We hope you have a great time at the regional, and that you and your dogs achieve goals...whether it be a podium spot, running with confidence, or simply getting through a course without Eing. 😊

Please read the following so you know what's what!

- **Time Table**

*This is subject to change depending on frost. We must wait until the all-clear from the friendly folks at the Kino Sports facility before we can get on the field.*

- **Arrival for competitors on Thursday** shall be no earlier than 3 PM. Competitor and RV check-in will be from 3 PM – 5 PM on Thursday. Please come to the Admin/Check-in area inside the field before you park your rig. All RVs must have pre-paid for their spots, and will receive a placard that must be displayed at all times. Please make sure you check in and you will be directed to your spot. If you are coming early to help set up, please see Leonda Armstrong for your RV spot and placard.
- **Thursday field set up begins at 12 PM.** Personal set up areas for competitors cannot be done prior to 3 PM. Please follow any posted signs or staff directions on where you can set up your canopies. When you set up, please note the following:
  - You cannot use any stakes that are more than 6" long – you can use weights, but with the possibility of wind, it's also best to back it up with stakes. If you set up along the fence, you can also use bungees to tie your canopy to the fence.
  - If you use a ground cover on the grass, it must be picked up each night.

These are venue requirements and will be enforced by them.

- **EVERYONE** needs to show me a height card at check-in. This is a Regional rule. PLUS, we will have SWAG for all competitors, so be sure to check-in!!
- **Course maps** will be posted by 8PM the night prior in the [Regionals 2026](#) folder on Google Drive, on the Wild West Facebook page, and in Agility Gate.
- **Your Chief Ring stewards are Denise Titzer and Julie Harbo.** We will have 3 rotations, so if you are on the off rotation, please consider volunteering. There will be sign-up sheets at each ring. Anyone who works 2 or more classes will be provided with lunch, raffle tickets for worker raffles, and our undying gratitude! 😊
- The **Veteran's Parade** will take place on Saturday during the course builds for the Regional GP and STP. Be sure to be attentive to the announcements so you know when to get your Vet ready for their 15 minutes of fame!

- **If you owe me GP Byes...**BE SURE to bring them and hand them to me. If you have one Bye and hope to earn another one on Friday, bring the one Bye with you so you can then hand them both to me!!
- In addition to the traditional **regional awards**, we will also have the following special awards:
  - **Contact Zonies Strategic Games.** Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to the teams who have the highest total scores from Gamblers and Snooker.
  - **Veterans Showcase.** Every Veteran entered in the Showcase will receive a medal. These medals are curtesy of Ernie Rodriguez...thank you Ernie!
- We will be using **Agility Gate**. The code will be sent out prior to the beginning of the trial.
- **Bitches in season** are allowed to run, but the dog must run in panties and must wear the panties around the field...except when pottying of course! 😊
- **Team walk-up songs** are always fun to have! If you want a specific walk-up song for your team, please be sure to visit our amazing DJ, Annie DeChance, and put down your top song plus a back-up just in case she doesn't have it.
- **Bring pictures of your USDAA-loving Pups!** They will be placed on our spectacular 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in honor of 40 years of USDAA agility! Please restrict the size of your picture to 4x4" so we can ensure that all dogs will be seen! 😊

- **Score Dispute Process**

You may dispute the following:

- Scribe error
- Timer malfunctions
- Misapplication of current USDAA rules
- Score table mistake

If you have a dispute, please come to the Admin table and complete the dispute form. Disputes will be reviewed by Masters judges on the trial committee. Their assessment will be based on **clear video evidence**. Judgement calls of the official in the ring during the run are NOT reviewable (i.e., missed contact, refusals, etc.). We will review only your run and not that of another competitor. Disputes must be submitted within 4 hours of the completion of the class that the run was performed. (except for Finals classes, which must be submitted prior to the Awards ceremony), and you must have video to review.

- **RV and Competitor parking** is designated in the diagram below. Note the following:
  - Competitor parking will be in the lot marked with the red square.
  - RV parking will be in the lots marked with the yellow and red squares

The Rock and Gem show is in the process of being setup, so there will be big white tents in the lot to the west of the field.
