Schedule:

Friday Setup: 3:00pm – 5:00pm **Ring/Equipment setup begins at 3:00pm.** Volunteers only may setup their canopies once equipment setup is complete. **Please leave your canopies/mats on the basketball court inside the field until ring setup is complete** except for Chief Ring Stewards, Chief Course Builders, Show Chair, Equip Mgr and Secretary).

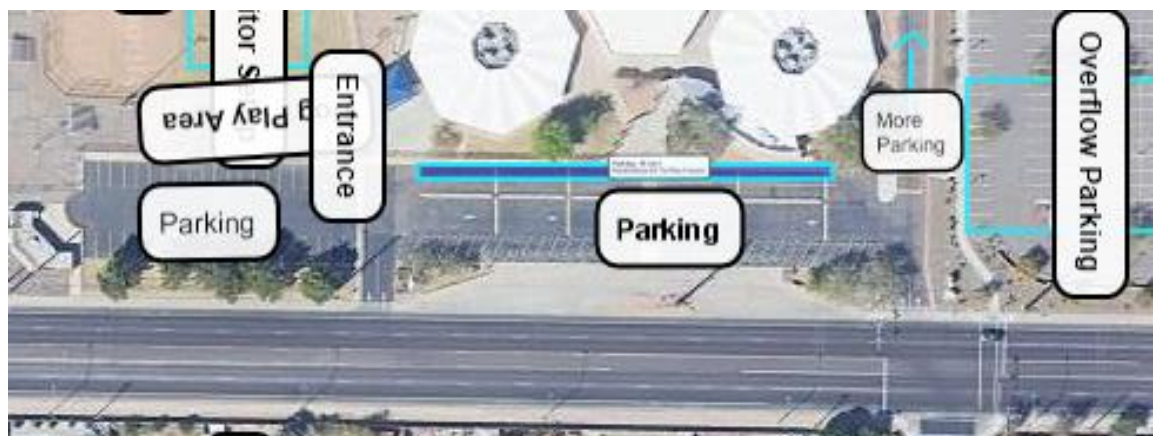
Saturday/Sunday: Gates open at 7:00am on Saturday; 6:45am on Sunday

Briefing 8:00am on Saturday; 7:45am on Sunday
Walk Thrus 8:10am on Saturday; 7:55am on Sunday
First Dog on the Line 8:30am on Saturday; 8:15am for Combined Pairs Only

Course Running: Ring 1 will take priority all weekend. Listen for announcements as to any special running order changes. Steeplechase, Grand Prix and Biathlon will be running by group to eliminate conflicts. Sunday, Ring 2 will start after Combined Pairs is finished in Ring 1.

Site Restrictions: Do not allow your dog to pee on anything man made, stay off playground, no smoking or alcoholic beverages, no firearms, no dogs in restrooms, please pick up poop even if it's not your dog's and place in GDA trash containers only (no poop in school trash cans).

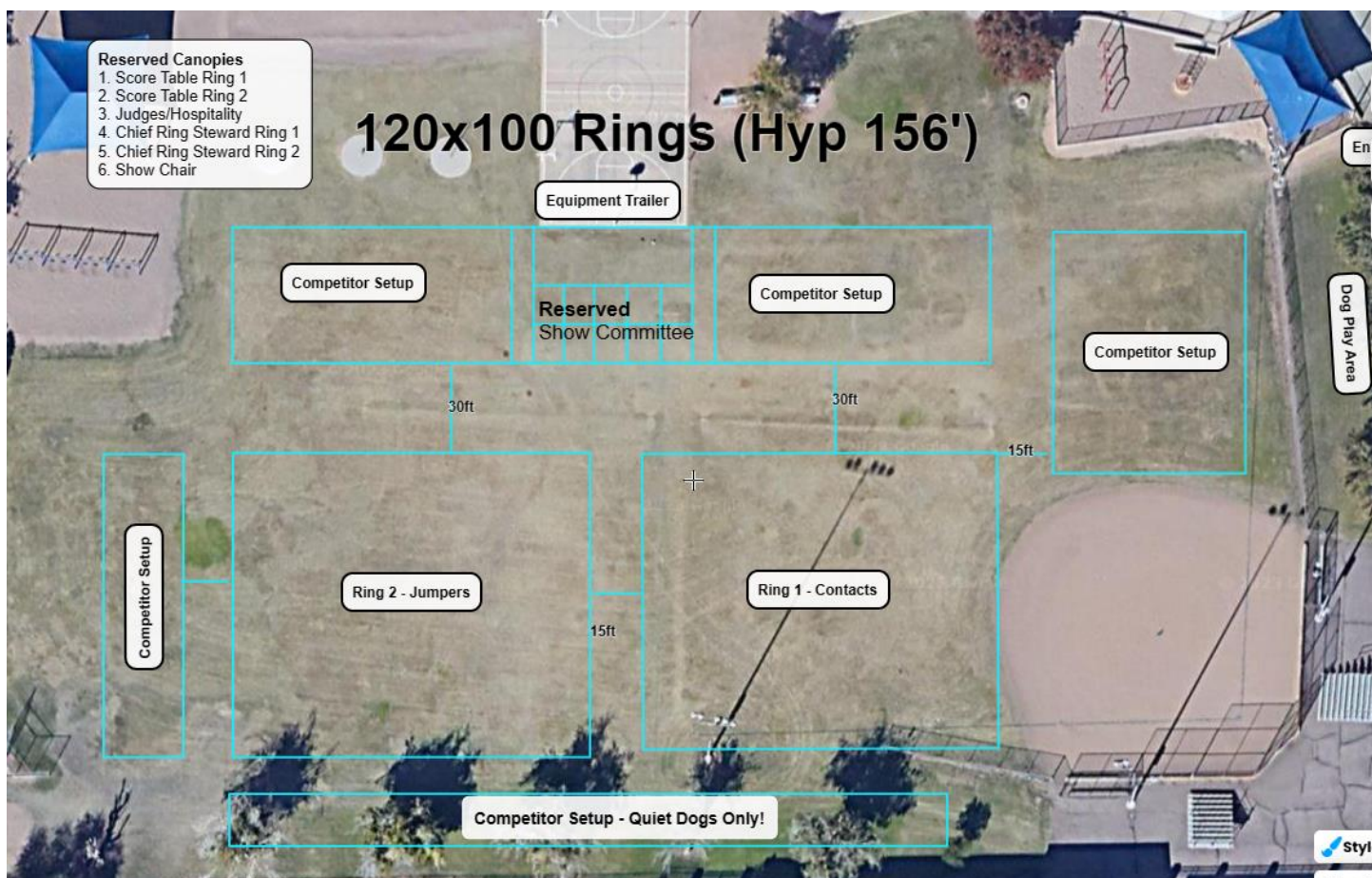
Setup: Competitor setup will be on Saturday at 7:00am unless you help setup on Friday afternoon at 3:00pm. There will be security at the site overnight, and the gates will be locked overnight. Leave your belongings at your own risk.

Parking: Cars can park in the two parking lots east of the school along Extension Rd. Larger vehicles/trucks/RV's/Overflow parking can park in the East end of Fiesta Sports Park parking lot, north of the school. There is a crosswalk directly onto the school grounds. Overnight RV's will be notified in advance of their parking area.



Field Layout:

There should be plenty of space for everyone to setup. We will mark the border with flags where you can set up behind to make sure there is adequate space away from the rings. **Ring 1 = Contact's Ring (Priority)** and **Ring 2 = Jumper's Ring**

**Food:**

A hot lunch will be available for volunteers at 11:30 each day in the hospitality tent. Snacks and water will be provided as well. Please use the hand sanitizer provided before serving your lunch.

Dog Play Area:

A fenced dog play area as shown on the map above is accessible to competitors through the dugout. If someone is already in the play area with their dogs, please ask them if you can bring your friendly dogs in to play. If the person does not want you to bring in your dogs, kindly wait your turn outside the dugout.
